STAFF REPORT

The Newcastle Fire Protection District responded to all-hazard emergencies throughout 2021. This year proved to be challenging with a long, dry summer and at times, a wet and intense winter. Newcastle Firefighters along with your command officers from Placer Hills Fire served the community by answering the call for duty 744 times in 2021. We are continuing to gather and improve the data that we provide to the public, the Board of Directors and internally to command and rank and file staff. Due to an RMS (record management system) change June 1, 2021, some data identified with an asterisk is estimated to be approximately 10% lower than actual. This is due to our legacy data not transferring into our new RMS and we continue to work with our vendor to provide the most accurate and up-to-date data. We anticipate finalizing 2021 data in the near future.
